

# Cilcain Village Gardens

You are invited to enjoy six gardens in the pretty village of Cilcain to raise funds for the National Gardens Scheme and the Village Hall Garden Maintenance Fund.

Some parking is available at the Village Hall, the Church, by the old Water Pumping Station, and at the car park to the west of the village. Disabled parking is also available at Delfryn, Stac Lee and at 6 Lon Cilcan. Enjoy a circular walk of about 1.5 miles to cover all the gardens.

First time opener Stac Lee (5) is a well planned and stocked garden with country views. Rest and admire the views at Nyth y Wennol (3) with its borders and veg plot. Delfryn (4) is a large well planted cottage garden with ponds, woodland, large vegetable plot, roses and seats to take a rest. Take a walk around Ty Mawr (2) with its flowery meadows and specimen trees and shrubs. The newly constructed Village Hall Garden provides a restful place to sit for a while. At 6 Lon Cilcan (1) you will find well stocked borders and a veg plot.
